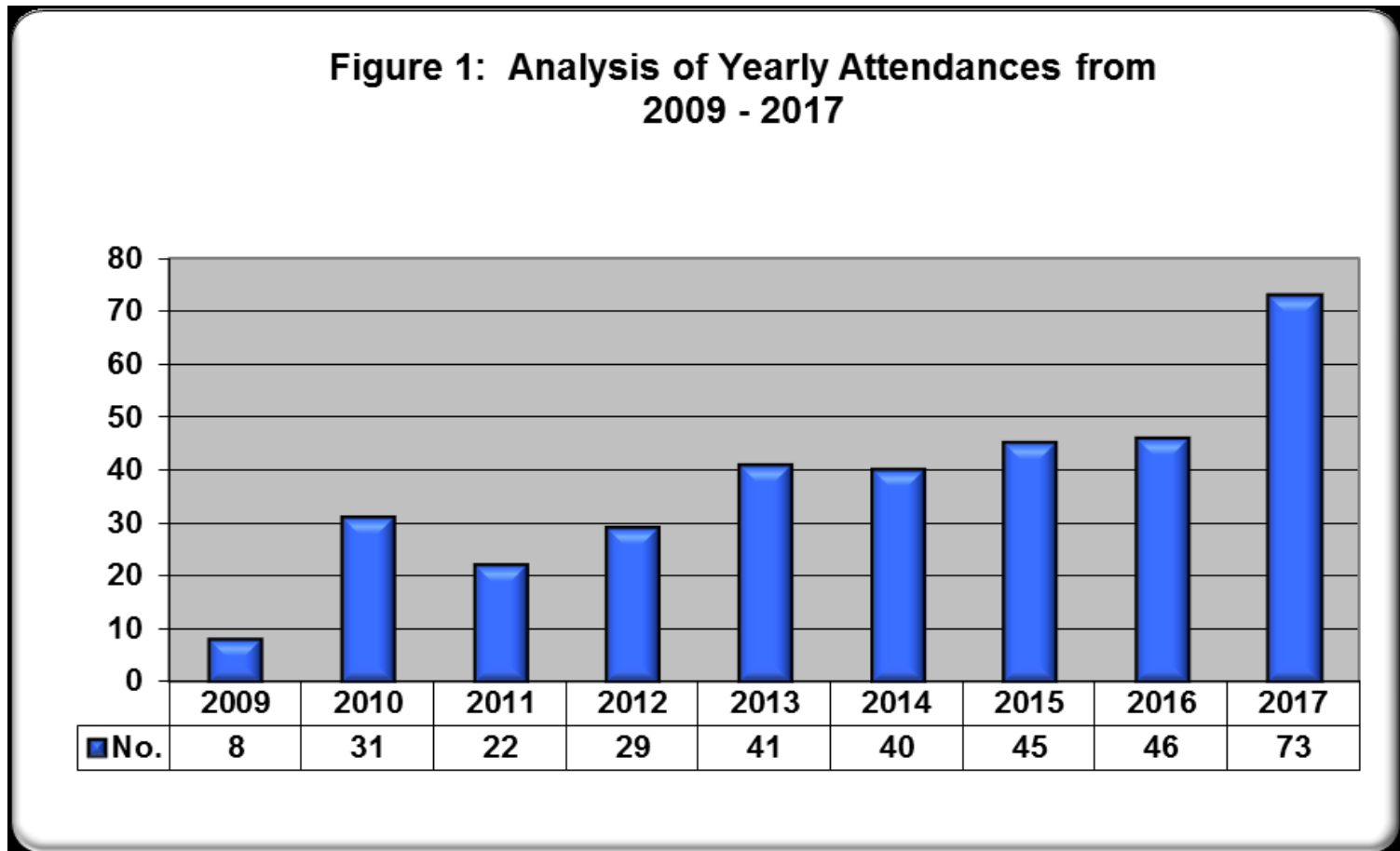
- National SATU Annual Stats 2017

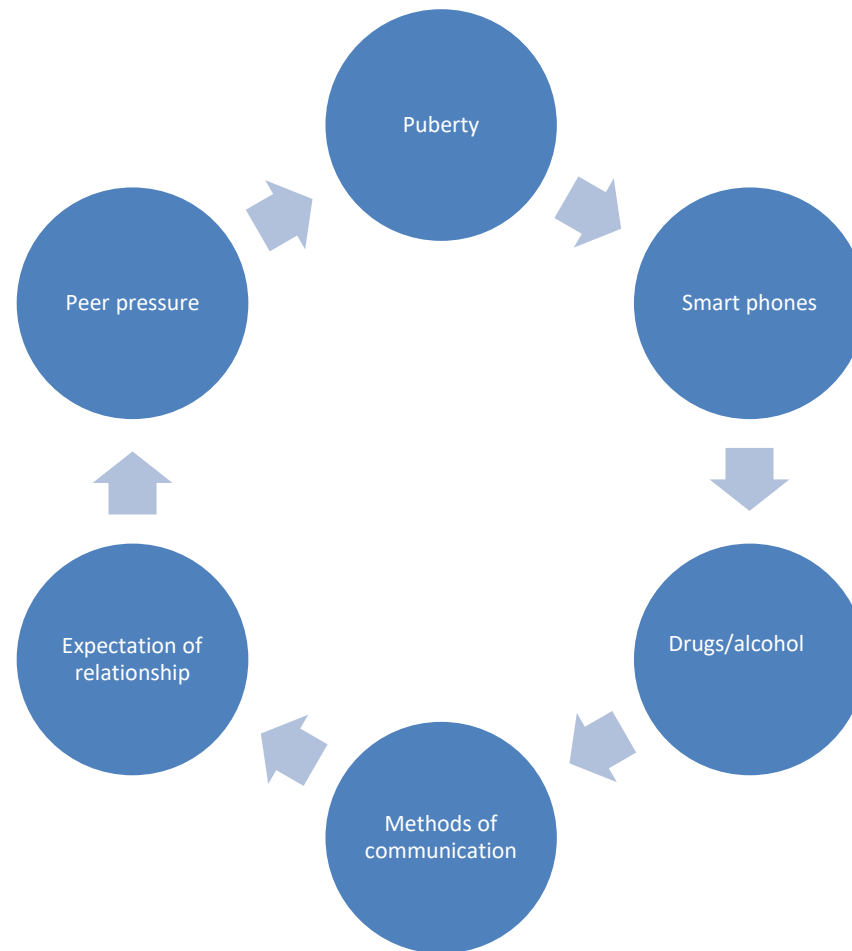

proximity of age' defence



This is sometimes call the “Romeo and Juliet Defence”.

This means that if a person has been charged with an offence of engaging in a sexual act with a person between the ages of 15 and 17 years he or she can put forward a defence but only if all of these conditions apply:

- the age difference between the two parties is not more than two years
- agreement was given freely and voluntarily
- neither party felt exploited or intimidated
- neither person is a person in a position of authority

- * What about the perpetrator?

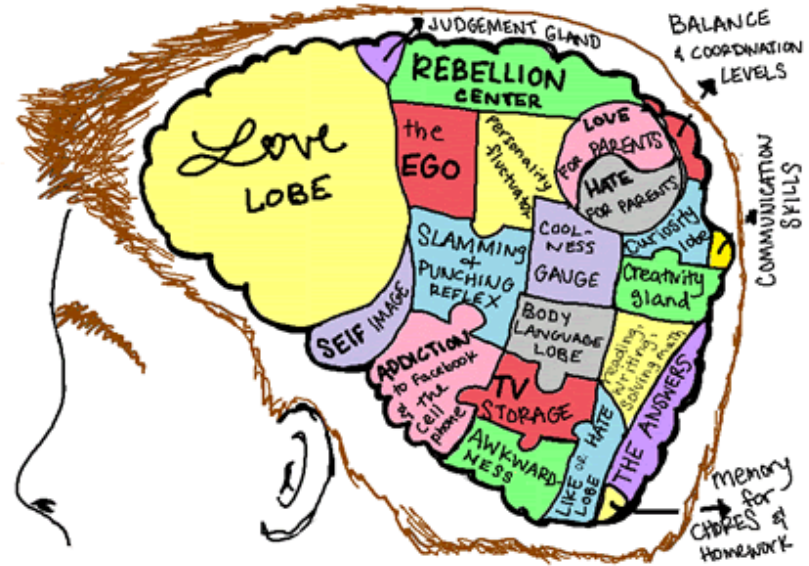

THE AVERAGE TEENAGE BRAIN



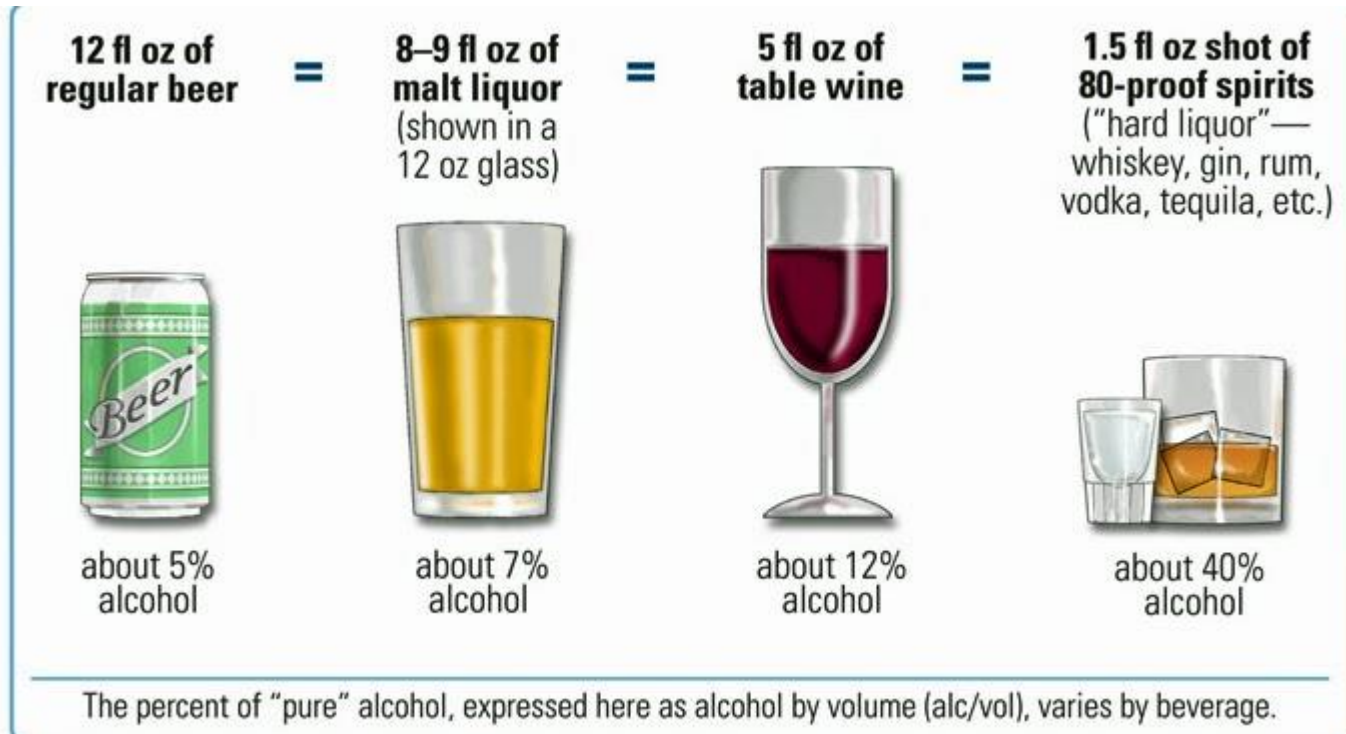
- Lets really talk puberty

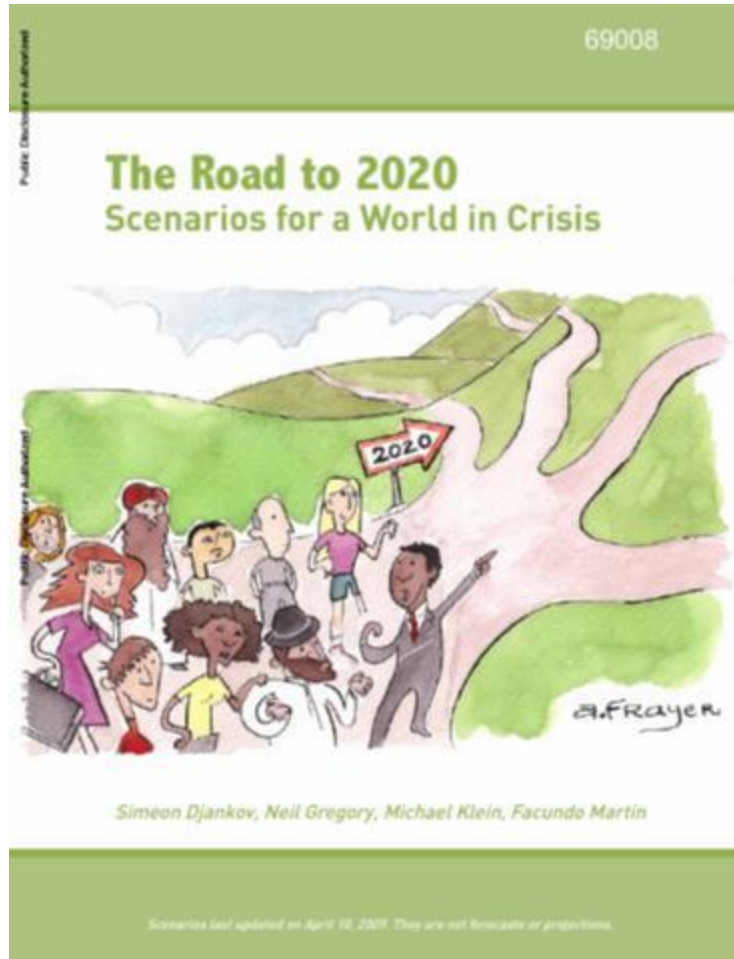
