Revision of Pay Rates in 2020 for Grant funded School Secretaries, Caretakers and Cleaners employed by the Boards of Management of Voluntary Secondary Schools in the Free Education Scheme and associated increases in Grant funding for same

Introduction

I am directed by the Minister for Education and Skills to refer to the pay of grant-funded School Secretaries and Caretakers and the Financial Emergency Measures in the Public Interest Act (*Unwinding of FEMPI – Public Service Stability Agreement 2018 – 2020*).

Key Dates

1 January 2020	*Annualised salaries up to €32,000 to increase by 0.5%. This applies to grant funded School Secretaries & Caretakers employed by schools whose pay is			
Unwinding of FEMPI	funded from SSSF, Secretary and Caretaker grants and who are paid on a salary scale equivalent to a public service salary scale and also Cleaners employed by schools using SSSF grant funding. Part A.1 and A.2 of this circular refer.

1 October 2020	Annualised salaries to increase by 2%. This applies to School Secretaries & Caretakers employed by schools whose pay is funded from SSSF, Secretary &			
Unwinding of FEMPI	Caretaker grants and who are paid on a salary scale equivalent to a public service salary scale and also Cleaners employed by schools using SSSF grant funding. Part A.1 and A.2 of this circular refers. (Facilitated by increase given in SSSF Grants in 2020)			

Note:

* The Arbitration agreement of 2015 concluded on 31st December 2019 2019 and no further additional funding will be provided.

PART A of this Circular which refers to pay increases under Financial Emergency Measures in the Public Interest Act (*Unwinding of FEMPI – Public Service Stability Agreement 2018 – 2020*) with effect from 1 January 2020 and 1 October 2020 applies to:

- School Secretaries and Caretakers employed by Boards of Management of schools whose pay is funded from the School Services Support Fund grants paid to schools by this Department and who **are** currently paid on a salary scale equivalent to a public service salary scale and to
- Cleaners employed by schools whose pay is funded from the School Services Support Fund or the Capitation grant paid to schools by this Department.

PART B of this Circular sets out the revised rates of School Services Support Fund Grant in order to enable schools to pay the revised rates set out in in Part A during 2020. It also sets out the rates of Secretary and Caretaker Grants.

PART A

Pay increases

- 1. The purpose of Part A of this Circular is to inform management authorities of the pay increases payable from 1 January 2020 and 1 October 2020 under the Financial Emergency Measures in the Public Interest Act (*Unwinding of FEMPI Public Service Stability Agreement 2018 2020*) to:
 - School Secretaries and Caretakers employed by Boards of Management of schools whose pay is funded from the School Services Support Fund grants paid to schools by this Department and who **are** currently paid on a salary scale equivalent to a public service salary scale and to
 - Cleaners employed by schools whose pay is funded from the School Services Support Fund or the Capitation grant paid to schools by this Department.

Application of the Financial Emergency Measures in the Public Interest Act (*Unwinding of FEMPI – Public Service Stability Agreement 2018 – 2020*)

- 1. In accordance with the Financial Emergency Measures in the Public Interest Act (unwinding of FEMPI Public Service Stability Agreement 2018 2020), the following increases are payable:
 - With effect from 1 January 2020, annualised salaries up to €32,000 increase by 0.5%
 - With effect from 1 October 2020, annualised salaries to increase by another 2%

The pay of part-time staff should be revised on a pro-rata basis, in accordance with normal arrangements, by reference to the pay of whole-time staff to which they are related for pay purposes. Please note that the pro-rata pay calculation is based on a whole time equivalent of 39 hours.

			The SSSF Grant is paid in three instalments in September, January and April.
			The grant is calculated at a minimum enrolment of 200 pupils and thereafter according to enrolment.
b)	Basic Secretarial Grant	€40.00	To qualify for this grant, a school must have an enrolment figure of at least 200 pupils. The grant is calculated by multiplying the enrolment figure by the rate up to a maximum of 350 pupils.
			Schools employing secretaries under 'the 1978 scheme do not receive any secretary grants
c)	SSSF Secretary Grant	€26.50	The grant is calculated by multiplying the enrolment figure by the rate up to a maximum of 350 pupils.
			Schools employing secretaries under 'the 1978 scheme' do not receive any secretary grants.
d)	Basic Caretaker Grant	€34.00	To qualify for the basic caretaker grant, a school must have an enrolment figure of at least 200 pupils. The grant is calculated by multiplying the enrolment figure by the rate up to a maximum of 350 pupils.
e)	SSSF Caretaker Grant	€20.50	The grant is calculated by multiplying the enrolment figure by the rate up to a maximum of 350 pupils.
