Following discussions at the Teachers Conciliation Council, it has been agreed that with effect from the commencement of the 2009/10 school year, a qualified post primary teacher

- a) who is employed by a recognised Community & Comprehensive School or Vocational Educational Committee and
- b) has a Contract of Indefinite Duration for 18 hours or more per week and
- c) agrees in writing to be timetabled up to 22 hours per week

may be timetabled and paid for 22 hours per week.

Form H 22 is attached for completion. This form must be returned to the Department/VEC to enable qualifying teachers have their salary adjusted.

The additional hours that may be awarded to any such CID holder must come from the schools/VEC's allocation.
